The "Flying Yankees" of the 103rd Airlift Wing, a unit of the Connecticut Air National Guard, stationed at Bradley Air National Guard Base will provide a FLYOVER by a C-130H Hercules. The C-130H Hercules is a four-engine turboprop military transport aircraft. Capable of using unprepared runways for takeoffs and landings, the C-130 was originally designed as a troop, medical evacuation, and cargo transport aircraft. Its mission is to provide theater cargo and passenger airlift.

Brendan was born in Norwalk, CT in 1935 and because of his father's employment, was raised in CT, MA, and central NY. At age 17 he joined the NY National Guard. In 1953 he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force. His Air Force career brought him to many duty stations. From training at Sheppard Field Wichita Falls, TX. to Moses Lake, WA. and on to Fairbanks, AK where he participated in air lifting radar supplies for the Dew Line "Distant Early Warning" defense program.. Upon returning he was assigned to 309th troop carrier group Ardmore OK and ended his active duty with the 60th Troop Carrier Wing Dreux France.

In 1958 he married Shirley Marie Dascano. They have three children, Drusilla, Brendan Jr and Kevin, three grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

Brendan retired after 37 years as a driver for Hoffman/Chevron. But besides work, he has given much of his time to serving the community. He volunteered at Pope John Paul Nursing home for eight years, Dorothy Day, coached Special Olympics Tennis for 16 years, volunteered for Challenged People in motion, Stamford golf program for 5 years and Asst Scoutmaster Troop 9, a merit badge counselor for the Fairfield County Boy Scouts.

He has also found time to be the, Commander Korean War Veterans for 17 years an active member Catholic War Veterans 1042, member of the Veterans Council, Viet Nam Traveling Wall committee, Board of Directors Wooster Cemetery.

In 2022 Brendan was Inducted CT Veterans Hall of Fame.


